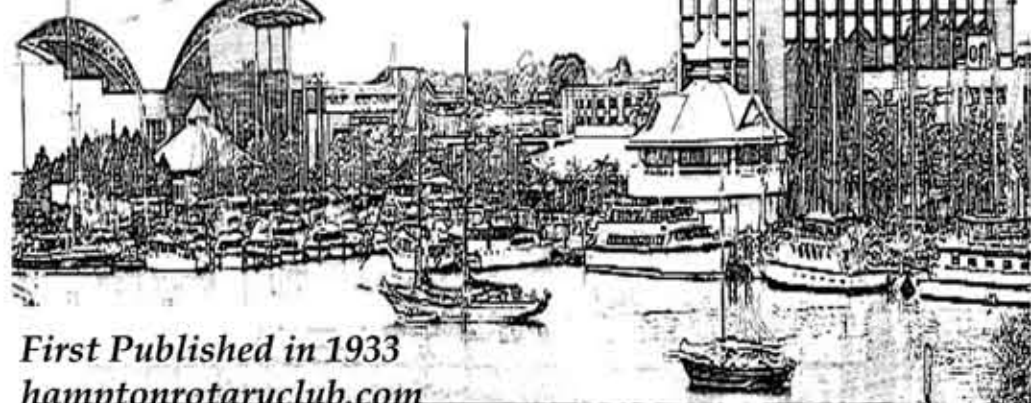

## A Report from the President.....



### Thank You Rotarians!!

What a banner year our Rotary Clubs had in 2014-15. You set a new record in total giving of \$748,418.55 (an increase of 10% from the previous total giving record) !! Your Annual Fund contributions are our second highest ever at **\$549,188.04.** You reached an Annual Fund per capita average of \$194.89. On top of all that, we gave over \$143,000 to PolioPlus. We are 'doing good in the world'..... thanks to YOU!

Over the last three years of District Grant awards, we have disbursed almost \$360,000 District Designated Funds in 61 grants to our Rotary Clubs to serve their communities. Over the last two years, The Rotary Foundation approved six of our Global Grants totaling almost \$269,000 to Honduras, Philippines, Ghana (2), Costa Rica and Rwanda. This year, TRF approved two grants totaling \$203,650 for community health in Ghana and community development in Rwanda. We also have a grant pending approval to Ecuador. **AND we are off to a great start to our "Be a Gift to the World" year.**
