Mr. Eugene Marshall, Jr.  
Director of Athletics at Hampton University



Effective July 1, 2014, Eugene Marshall, Jr. became the Director of Athletics at Hampton University, bringing with him nearly three decades of experience in collegiate athletics, from coaching on the sidelines to serving as an administrator. HU has added two new varsity programs under Marshall's leadership: women's soccer and men's lacrosse. The lacrosse program is the 70th Div. I team in the nation, and Hampton is the first HBCU to field a Div. I men's lacrosse team. Marshall also cultivated an apparel and shoe deal with Under Armour for the two new sports. Marshall also helped the Department receive the NCAA's AASP Grant for Academic Enhancement, totaling \$675,000 over three years. Every Friday, Marshall hosts "Kickin' It With the Coach" on WHOV 88.1 FM from 6-7 p.m. A 1981 graduate of Northeastern University, Mr. Marshall earned a bachelor's degree in business administration. He later completed his Master's degree in sports leadership at Northeastern in 2010. Mr. Marshall and his wife Phyllis, have three children, Jason, Jacqueline, and Eugene III.

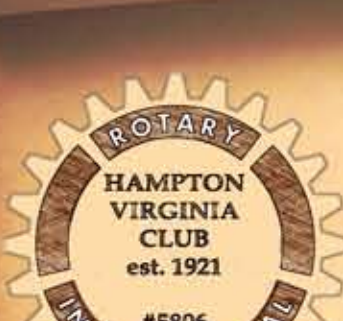


Every year, Bill and Melinda Gates publish an annual letter to broaden awareness and interest in key global health and development programs. This year's Annual Letter mentioned polio among their foundation's ongoing efforts to fight disease and inequality, specifically, the incredible progress that's been made towards polio eradication. Melinda Gates offers these kind words to reaffirm the important role Rotary has had leading the way to a polio-free world: "We're awed by the teams of vaccinators who take risks to reach each child. And we're inspired by the infinite persistence of Rotary International. They were leading this fight long before we joined it, and they've just kept moving forward." She goes on to say, "They know going from 350,000 cases to 37 is amazing, but success is zero." Even though a handful of polio cases have been reported this year, there is a chance these are the last cases of polio in history. This June, Bill Gates will speak at the Rotary International Convention in Atlanta, Georgia, USA to discuss how we can — and will — end polio together. Hope to see you in Atlanta. Jeff Templeman brings us, "By the Numbers"

- FED ACTION** - When the Fed began 2017, they were projecting 3 rate hikes for the year. After last week's 2-day meeting (held on May 2-3 which resulted in no rate change), the Fed has now raised short-term rates just 1 time in 3 meetings this year. There are 5 additional Fed meetings scheduled in 2017 (source: Federal Reserve).
- LOOKING AHEAD** - The personal savings rate in the USA was 5.9% as of 3/31/17. The personal savings rate in the USA was 1.9% as of 7/31/05, a record low in the country. The rate is defined as "savings" (i.e., after-tax income less consumption spending) divided by after-tax income (source: Department of Commerce).
- COMPROMISE** - In the debate to finalize fiscal year 2017 spending (i.e., discretionary spending for the 12 months ending 9/30/17), the Trump administration had requested \$30 billion in extra defense spending and \$3 billion more for border security. Congressional negotiators agreed on 4/30/17 to \$12 billion in extra defense spending and \$1.5 billion additional funding for border security (source: Congress).
