James Laughton Phillips, M.D., 82, passed away Thursday, November 11, 2021, in Hampton, Virginia. "Jim" or "Doc" to his family and friends. He was born in Morehead City, North Carolina, the son of Herbert Orlandah and Beatrice Laughton Phillips.

Jim graduated with a B.A. from the University of North Carolina, Chapel Hill, in 1961; he obtained his Doctor of Medicine from the same institution in 1965. From 1965 to 1971, Jim completed his medical internship and residency at the prestigious Johns Hopkins Hospital in Baltimore, Maryland. He was in the Navy during the Vietnam Era, holding the rank of Lieutenant commander and practicing orthopedics at the National Naval Medical Center in Bethesda, Maryland.

Dr. Phillips put his education and training to good use, practicing medicine for half a century. He was a founding member of Tidewater Orthopedic Associates in 1973. He truly loved every aspect of his profession, and it was this love that granted Jim the endurance to be an active surgeon until the age of 75!

Jim was particularly fond of his church, his Rotary club, being a founding member of H.E.L.P. (Hampton Roads Ecumenical Lodgings and Provisions), and volunteering for the Crippled Children's Clinic.
